

DERBYDOG INC DEMOLITION DERBY 2025 WINDSHIELD CAR CLASS GUT-N-GO CLASS 1/30/2025

-Any front-wheel drive, 2-wheel drive, sub-frame passenger car. All AWD vehicles must be made 2WD. **VEHICLE MUST BE KEY START.**

-Windshield optional to be removed. All other glass must be removed. All plastic, headlights, taillights, etc. must be removed prior to entering track.

-No drivetrain swaps permitted. Must be drivetrain for make/model of vehicle used.

-Battery may be relocated to inside car.

-Fuel tank may be relocated to back seat area or left in stock location.

-Rear seat bar permitted ONLY (Maximum 2"). No downlegs. NO OTHER WELDING PERMITTED ANYWHERE (except where noted)!

-All doors, hood, decklid MUST be wired, chained, or banded shut. No more than 6 places per seam. Sheet metal to sheet metal only. Driver's door may have a plate for safety.

-Bumpers must be bolted on **ONLY**. Factory OEM bumper with factory OEM bumper shocks in factory location. No bumper swaps! **NO AFTERMARKET BUMPERS!** OFFICIALS DECISION IS FINAL!

-Street tires ONLY! Factory production wheels. No added metal to wheels. D.O.T. 4-PLY MAX.! No foam-filled or solid tires. Tire pressures will be checked. We reserve the right to drill holes in tires after derby.

-No painting of frame, sub-frame, under hood, etc. permitted. Spray Foam is ONLY permitted around battery and/or around computer under hood.

-Headers permitted.

-Pre-ran cars are permitted. No added welding anywhere! If bumper tears off, bumper may be re-mounted in above welded manner. No shortening of front frame.

-No Fixit Plates permitted PERIOD. CHEAP!! EASY!! FUN!! -CHEAP! EASY! FUN! Don't ruin it for everyone else PLEASE!
